### The City of Lauderdale Lakes Introduce FY2016 Proposed Budget with Lower Tax Rate

The City of Lauderdale Lakes Financial Services Department is working diligently to prepare the Fiscal Year 2016 Budget. The All Funds Proposed Operating Budget is set at \$35.8 million and is available for review at [www.lauderdalelakes.org/finance](http://www.lauderdalelakes.org/finance).

According to sources, the FY2016 Budget should produce several reductions in Fire Rescue Assessments, Stormwater, and Solid Waste Assessments. Financial Services Director, Marie Elianor said "Fiscal Year 2016 is shaping up to be a kick start to the City Mayor and Commissioner's vision of a vibrant, active, attractive and safe Lauderdale Lakes. The staff is working extremely hard to include innovative projects and programs to cut costs and increase revenues in the proposed budget."

As the FY2015 year winds down, we will keep you updated on the Budget preparation for the new year. Lauderdale Lakes appears to be moving at a steady pace in a positive direction. You should see information relating to the General Fund, and the Operating Budget in the well prepared budget booklet.

Acting City Manager, Danny Holmes was all smiles when asked about the progress of the FY2016 budget thus far. He said, "We are excited about this years budget. The overall result should excite the Lauderdale Lakes residents and that, to me, means we are moving ahead in a positive direction. At the end of the day, the budget is not just an collection of numbers, but it is an expression of our values and aspirations for the City of Lauderdale Lakes."
