Community Bus Service

The City of Lauderdale Lakes and Broward County Transit (BCT) have partnered to provide the Lauderdale Lakes East/West Route. This community bus service will increase the number of destinations and connections that can be reached through public transit. Destinations along the Lauderdale Lakes East/West Route include: Lauderdale Lakes City Complex, Oakland Estates Community, Florida Medical Center, Hawaiian Gardens, Inverrary Falls Publix, Oakland Park Blvd and US 441 (Walmart) and surrounding neighborhood.

Connections are available to BCT Routes 18, US 441 Breeze, 56, 72, 81, Lauderhill 1, 5, 2, 3, 4 and the Lauderdale Lakes North/South Community Bus.

All buses on this route are air-conditioned and wheelchair accessible in accordance with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA). Bicycle Racks are also provided. Please refer to this pamphlet for instruction on how to correctly use the bicycle racks.

The Lauderdale Lakes Community Bus Route is free of charge, but riders making connections to BCT routes are expected to pay the appropriate fares.

HOURS OF OPERATION

Monday through Friday

9:00 am - 5:53 pm

The Lauderdale Lakes North/South Route operates approximately every 80 minutes, with assigned stops.

Please refer to the timetable and map on the reverse side of this pamphlet. The bus will operate as close to schedule as possible. Traffic conditions and/or inclement weather may cause the bus to arrive earlier or later than the expected time. Please allow yourself enough time when using this service.

The Lauderdale Lakes North/South Community Bus Route will not operate once a hurricane warning has been issued or if other hazards do not allow for the safe operation of the bus.

HOLIDAYS

The Lauderdale Lakes East/West Route does not operate on the following holidays:

- New Year's Day • Martin Luther King, Jr.
- President's Day • Memorial Day
- Independence Day • Veteran's Day
- Thanksgiving Day and the day after Thanksgiving
- Christmas Day

BIKE RACKS

Bike Racks are available on the Lauderdale Lakes East/West Community Bus. Bike Racks are designed to carry two bikes only. It is important to have the operator's attention before loading and unloading your bike. As the bus approaches, have your bike ready to load. Remove any loose items that may fall off.

Loading

- Always load your bike from the curbside of the street.
- Lower-Squeeze the handle and pull down to release the folded bike rack.
- Lift your bike into the rack, fitting the wheels into the slots of the vacant position closest to the bus.
- Latch-Pull and release the support arm over the front tire, making sure the support arm is resting on the tire, not on the fender or frame.

Unloading

- Before exiting, notify the operator you are removing your bike.
- Pull the support arm off the tire. Move the support arm down and out of the way. Lift your bike out of the rack. If your bike is the only one on the rack, return the rack to the upright position.
- **Move quickly to the curb.**






Community Bus Service Routes and Timetables
